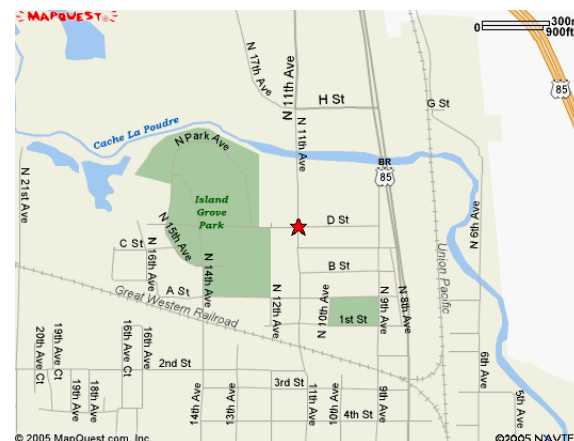

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing. All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited at AKC Obedience Trials or Rally Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

SHOW SITE INFORMATION

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm, Thursday, August 19, 2010. The site will again be available at 6:00 am on Friday, August 20, 2010.

The grounds at this show include the show buildings, outside show grounds, and all parking areas.

There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to their crates or exercise pens, except when being judged.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and have appropriate vaccinations.

Crates must be stacked when ever possible in all grooming areas.

Reserved grooming space is available in the air conditioned Exhibition Building, free grooming is available in the Livestock Building. Exercise Pens may be set up in the Livestock Building. Information for reserved grooming is in the GKC show premium available at WWW.ONOFRIO.COM.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions at, and around their set-up area.

Dogs may be exercised ONLY in designated areas outside the building.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Pooper-Scoopers will be placed around the show grounds. If your dog soils in the show ring, the stewards will hold your dog while you do the clean-up.

NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.

Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs, but due to space constraints, seating may be restricted.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be indoor crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site. X-pens may be set up in the Livestock Barn. Individual chair seating may not be allowed, if space prohibits. Mats used under crates must match the dimensions of the crate. Excess matting will not be allowed. Please be prepared to stack crates.

PARKING REGULATIONS

The only entrance into the show site will be off 11th Ave (14th Ave will be closed at 'B' St. from Thursday through Sunday, August 19-22, 2010. GKC reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate any way necessary. GKC solely determines if said animal is in distress. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal. No vehicles will be allowed to enter the park between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM. No dogs outside vehicles between 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM. All parking is subject to control of the Greeley Kennel Club. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles must be kept clean at all times. No dumping of holding tanks, grey water, or sewage on the show grounds. All parking will be on a first come basis. Extra spaces may not be saved by roping off, using empty crates, exercise pens, chairs or equipment. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. The City of Greeley and the show giving club will not be responsible for loss by fire, burglary, theft, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents. Violators of these parking regulations will be prosecuted and vehicles towed away, at the owners expense, without notice.

DAY PARKING

The paved lot south of the stadium is available for day parking. There are no electric hook ups. Additional day parking is available on the east side of the park and west of the show buildings.

OVERNIGHT PARKING

Please consult the GKC show premium for complete overnight parking information available at WWW.ONOFRIO.COM. Overnight parking will be available near the show grounds. Overnight parking is a privilege extended by the Greeley Kennel Club, and this privilege will be withdrawn from those who do not follow the rules, regulations and instructions of the officers on duty. Any breach of these terms will be reported to the Show Committee. The fees are charged to help defray the cost of security guards.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Questions regarding the Canine Partners Program should be sent to akccaninepartners@akc.org. **This Club is not offering entries to All American/Mixed Breed dogs.**

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00 per entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.
