This trial will be held indoors, in two dirt rings, run concurrently.

Ring Measurements Minimum 100' x 90'each

Judging to begin 10:00 AM on Friday, 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday

Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates. The building will be available Friday, April 9, 2010 after 9:00 AM for set-up. It will be available April 10-11, 2010 at 7:00 AM. Limited crating areas will be provided on the arena floor. No crating allowed in bleachers, bleacher area, or walkways. No chairs will be allowed in the crating areas. There is ample bleacher seating available. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading. X-pens are allowed for 3 or more dogs. Horse stalls will be available for crating. Check for information at trial regarding availability.

Since the Judging program favors your later arrival, we want to be sure we can offer some crating space for you at that time. We will attempt to save adequate space for your entered dog(s). MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries for Friday, April 9, 2010 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, April 5, 2010. Move-up entries for Saturday, April 10, 2010 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Friday, April 9, 2010 at the trial site. Move-up entries for Sunday, April 11, 2010 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, April 10, 2010 at the trial site. Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing trial date. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the running order.

CONFLICTS

The Standard Ring always takes precedence, so please try to resolve any conflicts by running order changes in the Jumpers with Weaves ring. Do not indicate ring conflicts during self-check-in. Ring conflicts must be handled at ringside with the approval and consent of the gate steward and judge for that ring. Please be sure to walk your course during a scheduled time period. If you are running in a different ring during your walk through, please walk with a different group and run with that group.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. Arm bands will be available by self-check in for all dogs/handlers who indicated they have a permanent AKC Height Card on their entry form. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. IT IS THE EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO KNOW IF THEY NEED TO BE MEASURED, AND BE MEASURED PRIOR TO THEIR RUN. There will be a VMO present at this trial.

The following is the procedure for dogs that have not been measured by a VMO or Field Rep:

- If a VMO or Field Rep. is available, the dog should be measured before it runs. This will start the process toward getting a dog an AKC Jump Height Card.
- If a VMO or Field Rep. can not measure the dog before it runs, then the judge(s) of record needs to measure the dog prior to running. This measurement will only be effective for that set of trials.
- Dogs will no longer need to be measured by a judge of record if the handler has a valid height card or valid yellow height card form(s) in their possession.

Official measurements after a dog runs:

If a VMO or Field Rep. measures a dog after it runs and this measurement changes the jump height it is in, the measurement is effective the next day and for all future trials. If this occurs, keep in mind the following:

- If this measurement would move the dog to a higher jump height in the Regular Classes, this would also happen on the next day or trial in which the dog is entered. If the height would move the dog to a lower jump height, the dog would only be allowed to move down into that jump height at the next trial in which the dog is entered if that trial has not closed.
- If the dog is entered in the Preferred Classes, and the measurement from the VMO or AKC Field Rep. would change the jump height either up or down, this change is effective immediately for all trials in which the dog is entered regardless of whether or not the trial has met the closing date for entries.

Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors are required to wear the provided armbands.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.
